18. Community Services:

An amount of Rs 1500 was raised and given to the school for the welfare of students. 28 Computer and Internet access and training to teachers and students:

Computer and Internet access is available to the teachers as well as the students of Self Financed Courses.

In the Aided Section, separate Internet facility is also available to the teachers and students of the Departments of Chemistry, Physics, Botany and Zoology in their respective laboratories. This facility is also available in the Library.

31. Activities and support from the Parent Teacher Association:

Some of the heads of the departments informally call the parents of the defaulters to discuss their performance, attendance etc. on one to one basis.

32. Health Services:

- **Malaria check-up drive:** Organized in association with BMC, an 'on the spot' Malaria Testing was conducted for the students of our college on September 18, 2010. In addition to Malaria, tests were also conducted for viral infection, seasonal fever, and other ailments. More than 100 students got themselves tested in this drive.
- **Thalassaemia check up drive:** The drive was held in association with Rotary Club, Prabha Devi, Mumbai branch, on August 18, 2011. A class to class campaign was arranged to spread awareness for this genetic disorder. Thalassaemia major has no cure whereas those having Thalassaemia minor needs to be careful while choosing their life partners. The target group for this program were the students of third year of all the streams of 129 students who got themselves tested for Thalassaemia, four were found to be positive. Counseling session was held for them in the month of January, 2011.
- **Blood donation drive:** It was held on Jan, 23, 2011 in association with Meenatai Thackerey Blood Bank of Prabodhan. One hundred twenty nine units

were collected in this drive. A class to class awareness campaign was conducted on the previous day by Dr Panchhwani of the blood bank. In addition to this, different posters collected and prepared by volunteers were displayed at prominent places to spread the message for this noble cause. The response was tremendous. More than 230 students came forward. Medical expert of the blood bank found only 129 to be fit for donation. Rest were found to be anemic, on some medication or had suffered from some ailment in past three months.

- **HIV/AIDS Awareness program:** Initiated and supported by Maharashtra District AIDS Control Society and implemented through the services of cadre officers of the State's National Service Scheme (NSS), these programs are conducted by the Red Ribbon Club. RRC is a voluntary on-campus program of students under NSS, which, this year has worked tirelessly to generate awareness regarding -
 - ✓ How can HIV/AIDS be transmitted?
 - ✓ Who is most vulnerable?
 - ✓ How can you prevent yourself from contracting HIV?
 - ✓ How do you think people would react if you had HIV/AIDS?
 - ✓ What are the stigmas attached to HIV/AIDS?
 - ✓ What could organizations and governments do to help AIDS orphans?

Department of English

Department of Psychology

- On December 18, 2010, SYBA students of Psychology were taken for a visit to the **M. N. Banajee Industrial Home for Blind Men** at Jogeshwari (W). Blind men from all over India are trained in various tasks like making of cane-furniture, steel hangers, hinges, wax candles and diyas, dusters, napkins, bed sheets and such other sundry items, with a view to making them self-sufficient. Basic and advanced computer training is provided to educated men. The Home also has tie ups with various industrial houses such as Tata Consultancy Services and Apna Bazaar who employ the trained inmates and/ or buy goods prepared by them. Hostel facility is provided for inmates coming from out of the city.

The aim of the visit was to show students the immense courage, talent and spirit of these men and to encourage them to think of what one can do instead of lamenting about what one ‘cannot’ do. Students were highly impressed with the work of the inmates and many of them also purchased a number of items prepared by them.

- On January 12, 2010, Ms. Pragati Diddi and Ms. Tanvi Patel, both students of SYBA Psychology addressed the class of SYBA Psychology, and spoke on **Autism and Learning Disabilities**. Ms. Diddi spoke on ‘Autism’ – its causes, symptoms and management. Ms. Patel spoke particularly on three types of Learning Disabilities, namely, **Dyslexia, Dysgraphia** and **Dyscalculia**. The speech was accompanied with apt examples and followed by discussion.]

B) Extension Activities

1) N.C.C. Unit

This year, the unit organised various activities.

- 1) Formation: At the beginning the current academic year, 120 students were sent to enroll for NCC. However, only 27 Cadets were selected for 1st year.
- 2) Orientation Programme: An orientation programme was conducted by A.N.O. Capt. (Dr.) R. R. Wagh. A meeting of the parents was held to familiarize themselves with NCC.
- 3) Oath Ceremony: On the event of Independence Day celebration, oath-taking ceremony of the cadets was held by the Honorable Chief Guest Dr. M. B. Kekare in College premises.
- 4) Festival Celebration: As every year, the unit celebrated Dassera festival. On this occasion ‘Poojan’ of Rifles, NCC Office and Store Room Material was performed by the cadets.
- 5) Social Service Activities: The purpose of introducing Social Service activities in the NCC is to make the Cadets conscious and sensitive to the needs and problems of their fellow citizens. Under the guidance of Capt. (Dr.) R. R. Wagh, the following social service activities were organised.

3) N.S.S. Unit

1) Adopting Punarvas:

Punarvas is a school for special children of our society. The inmates of the school, the mentally disabled kids are given special training so that the students can perform small tasks of their life independently. The interaction with such students make the youth sensitive towards this section of our society, it was with this aim and objective that it was decided to adopt Punarvas as Area based project of NSS. During the first visit to the school, NSS volunteers carried a cleanliness drive and tree plantation program in the school premises. An area in the backyard of the school had become a dumping ground of unwanted items thrown as waste. The items were segregated and the area was cleaned. There after saplings and cuttings of various ornamental and medicinal plants were planted in the area. It took 8 hours for volunteers to complete the entire work.

2) Extending the Hand of financial Help:

NSS volunteers raised money by selling rakhies prepared by mentally and physically challenged special children of Punarvas. An amount of Rs 1500 was raised and given to the school for the welfare of students. Similarly, an amount of Rs.2500 was raised by sale of flags made by special members of Hi-tech enrichment family foundation.

3) Blood donation drive:

It was held on Jan, 23, 2011 in association with Meenatai Thackary Blood Bank of Prabodhan. One hundred twenty nine units were collected in this drive. A class to class awareness campaign was conducted on the previous day by Dr Panchhwani of the blood bank. In addition to this, different posters collected and prepared by volunteers were displayed at prominent places to spread the message for this noble cause. The response was tremendous. More than 230 students came forward. Medical expert of the blood bank found only 129 to be fit for donation. Rest were found to be anemic, on some medication or had suffered from some ailment in past three months.

4) HIV/AIDS Awareness program:

Initiated and supported by Maharashtra District AIDS Control Society and implemented through the services of cadre officers of the State's National Service Scheme (NSS), these programs are conducted by the Red Ribbon Club. RRC is a voluntary on-campus program of students under NSS, which, this year has worked tirelessly to generate awareness regarding -

- ✓ How can HIV/AIDS be transmitted?
- ✓ Who is most vulnerable?
- ✓ How can you prevent yourself from contracting HIV?
- ✓ How do you think people would react if you had HIV/AIDS?
- ✓ What are the stigmas attached to HIV/AIDS?

- ✓ What could organizations and governments do to help AIDS orphans?

5) **Adopting a tribal village and special residential camp report - Youth for Clean Environment:**

Duration: 7 days.

From: 29 October, 2010 - 4 November, 2010

Place: Velkari village, Kaaman, Vasai (E).

Participants: 68 NSS volunteers and 2 staff members.

Velkari is a small tribal basti situated in the Kaaman village of Vasai taluka in Thane district. With a population of 1500 only, the community faces the problem of drinking water, unemployment, illiteracy, alcoholism, malnutrition and related ailments. Seven days residential camp in the community area brought volunteers close to the tribal and helped them understand their social and personal problems. This made them sensitive towards the need of society and their role there in. Cleanliness drive and tree plantation were few of the prime agendas. Divided into five groups of 12-14 volunteers each, they worked hard to give their best in shramdaan, cleanliness drive, tree plantation and other jobs of management and arrangement of food, water, etc.

During seven days residential camp special emphasis was laid on the personality of volunteers. Yoga, morning exercises, and meditation were conducted on regular basis. This opened up volunteers, brought them close to each other, and to themselves as well. Yoga teacher and our Vice Principal Prof. A.G.Gadre who visited the camp on one of the days conducted a powerful yoga/meditation session. He guided volunteers with respect to their personal and professional problems. The camp was successful in bringing positive transformation in the lives of a number of students.

Group song competition, Elocution Competition and Street play preparation on varied topics such as patriotism, Mother Teresa, anti-alcohol and HIV/AIDS helped volunteers come out of their fear of performance and speech. The competition was judged by Dr A.G.Gadre and the winners were awarded with trophies by him during the annual function of January 26, 2011.

6) **Patkar College Red ribbon Club**

The club had total membership of **575** volunteers of which 6 volunteers were the peer leaders, who coordinated, organized and successfully implemented various programs and activities of the club. All the programs and activities of the club were aimed at Spreading awareness regarding HIV/AIDS among students, common man and general public. Some highlights of the club are as follows-

- **HIV/AIDS Slogan writing competition** - Aug.4, 2010: One hundred fifty students (Non-NSS) participated in the slogan writing competition organized by RRC. Two hundred membership forms were filled up.
- **Street Play on HIV/AIDS by Patkar RRC** - Aug.15, 2010:: Patkar RRC club performed a street play on AIDS in Marathi during cultural program of Independence Day. The play was directed by Ms Vishakha of S.Y.B.Sc. It was well appreciated by the audience.
- **Street Play on HIV/AIDS by MDACS** - Sept.18, 2010: An audience of 200 students and teachers staff was present to see the play performed by team of Sathye College organized by MDACS. RRC membership forms were filled up.
- **Participation of RRC members in Intl. Youth Day Events** - Organized by MDACS from Aug.10 - Aug.13,2010, six members of RRC Club participated as volunteer in the organization of the event. RRC members also participated in poster making competition and elocution competitions of the event
- **Popular talk and slide show on HIV/AIDS** - Sept.22, 2010: An audience of 180 students and teachers staff was present to hear the lecture delivered by Premanand Ghag on HIV/AIDS.

1. Biometric system of attendance will be introduced for all teaching and non-teaching staff.
2. Unique Bar Code System under OMR type of marking will be introduced for internal examination.
3. The College plans to work towards enhancing the I.C.T. enabled tools in office and in teaching.
