Revised schemes of courses of study leading to degrees of B.A., B.Sc. and B.Com. under the three year integrated degree pattern.

B. A. Degree Course

- A three-year integrated course leading to the degree of Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) was introduced in the Faculty of Arts with effect from June, 1977.
- A student for the B.A. degree examination will be required to offer 20 papers, and that the breakup of these papers will be as under:
Core (Special Subjects) - 17 papers
(including 2 papers of an Applied Nature related to the core Papers)
Foundation course Group - 2 papers.
General Applied Component - 1 Paper.

▶ First Year B. A. - 6 Papers

(Total 600 marks - each of 100 marks)

(Total 800 marks - each paper of 100 marks)

Six Papers - Two papers in each of the optional subjects, selected from Papers III to VI studied in the First Year of the Course.

Six Papers in any one of the Optional Subjects offered at the Second Year of which two papers are of an applied nature related to the Core Subject.

A student shall study three papers in each of two major subjects chosen from the three subjects offered at the second Year of which one paper in each of the subjects will be of an applied nature (i.e. subject I - Paper VI and Subject II - Paper VI).

Note:

For the papers of applied nature at the TY.B.A. the evaluation will be partly internal. This internal evaluation will be based on seminars, projects, self-study, library work, etc.

The division of subjects prescribed for the B.A. degree examination is in four groups viz.

- (1) Languages Group,
- (2) Social Sciences Group,
- (3) Foundation Course Group and
- (4) General Applied Component.

- ❖ Foundation Course Group (2 papers)
 - ▣ Foundation Course, Paper-I - Social awareness and Personality development
 - ▣ Foundation Course, Paper-II - Scientific Method, Science Technology & Development, etc.

- ❖ General Applied Component Paper
 - ▣ Population Studies
