

## B. Com. Degree Course

- ❖ A three-year integrated course leading to the degree of Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com.) was introduced in the Faculty of Commerce with effect from June, 1980.
- ❖ A student for B.Com. degree examination shall be required to offer 20 papers from the four groups of subjects as follows :-
  - i) Foundation Course Two Papers
  - ii) Applied Component Group Four Papers
  - iii) Commerce Discipline Compulsory Twelve Papers
  - iv) Special Group Two Papers
- ❖ The following shall be the subjects prescribed for study for the B.Com degree course and the papers assigned to each subject.

### ▶▶ I - Foundation Course Group - Two papers

### ▶▶ II - Applied Component Group - Four Papers

- Export Marketing
- Computer System & Applications
- Direct & Indirect Taxation
- Introduction to Management Accounting (Special Group)
